Welcome to the privacy notice for St Neots and Huntingdon Methodist Circuit which is part of the East Anglia Methodist District within the Methodist Church in Great Britain.

The 14 local Methodist churches, together with the Circuit, District and the Methodist Church in Great Britain all respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal information (**personal data**).

This privacy notice (also called the privacy policy) lets you know how we look after your **personal data** which either you provide to us or we obtain and hold about you, and it tells you about your **privacy rights** and **how the law protects you**.
